DOWNEAST CHALLENGE OF THE BREEDS:

Classes 28, 35, 50, 86, 105, & 119 are the qualifying classes for the Challenge of the Breeds. Exhibitor's top 4 results from these classes will be used. Exhibitors may enter into all 6 or simply the minimum of 4 required for scoring. Classes 28 and 119 are mandatory and results of these classes will be revealed Sunday at lunchtime when the COB awards are announced. Entry fee for the COB is \$35. All class entry fees must still be paid. Both judges' scores will be added for results. Point scoring will be based on placings in each class: 1st 10 points, 2nd 8 points, 3rd 6 points, 4th 5 points, 5th 4 points, 6th 2 points, 7th 1 point. If ties occur in final standings, they will be broken by highest placings (most 1sts, if still tied, most 2nds, etc.) If tie is still in tact, results from 5th and then 6th classes will then be added. If still tied, will be awarded as such). Awards: 1st \$200 2nd \$100 3rd \$75 4th \$50 5th \$40 6th \$35

This division is open to any mount deemed suitable for a beginning/inexperienced rider.

It is not restricted to lesson program horses and ponies. However, these classes do qualify those meeting Academy Rule Requirements for the Academy Finals.

Open to Saddle, Hunter and Western Seat riders. Saddle Seat riders must not have shown in any show wearing a suit and are to be attired in Kentucky jods, boots, shirt and tie (vest, gloves, optional). Helmets are mandatory for riders 11 and under. No derbies.

Hunter Seat riders must not have shown with a jacket and are to be attired in jods, boots, shirt and tie/choker. Gloves are optional. Helmets are mandatory for all hunt seat riders. Western Seat riders must not have shown in any recognized show wearing standard stock seat outfit.

They are to show with boots and suitable pants, shirt and tie. Western hat/vest are optional with riding helmet mandatory for 11 and under riders. Full bridles, snaffles with or without martingales and other suitable bridles may be used. Lesson Rider mounts may be shown in regular horse show classes by other riders. Lesson riders are not to show in the regular horse show classes, and may not cross-enter among the lesson rider sections.

Lesson Rider Equitation to be judged on the basic principles of horsemanship. Lesson-Rider Pleasure to be judged on manners, suitability for a novice rider, and performance with quality NOT to count. Academy classes may be divided if necessary.
