## GENERAL RULES AND INFORMATION:

### EVERY CLASS RECOGNIZED BY THE MAINE HORSE ASSOCIATION WILL BE CONDUCTED AND JUDGED UNDER THE CURRENT RULES OF THE MAINE HORSE ASSOCIATION

\*\*\*NEHC Rated Class Specifications can be read in the current NEHC Rule Book.\*\*\*

1. Ring 1 will start PROMPTLY at 8:30 a.m. Rings 2 & 3 will start promptly at 8:00 a.m. with Unjudged Warm-ups running from 7:00-7:45 a.m. No numbers will be taken after 7:45. Other than warm-ups, there will be no schooling on the hunter courses. Warm-up tickets may be purchased with your entries at the Show Office. Conduct of the warm-up sessions will be at the discretion of the Hunt Rings Chairpersons whose decisions shall be final. The Hunter Courses are grassy areas.
2. **All Championships:** To be eligible, respective horses/riders must have been entered, shown and judged in the class listed in parentheses ( ).
3. No horse may enter its class until an entry blank has been completed, signed, fees paid & number assigned. The Management reserves the right to decline any entry & return any entry fees prior to the opening of the show without being liable for compensations.
4. REFUNDS: There will be no refunds on entry fees unless due to a bona fide injury of horse, exhibitor or exhibitor's family. Request for refund must be received by the Show Manager before the end of the show for consideration.
5. Six ribbons will be given in all classes with trophy/money as indicated.
6. LUNCH BREAK, if any, in Rings 2 & 3 will be announced. **Exhibitors cross-entered among the three rings are solely responsible for being on time for their respective classes.**
7. PRIZE MONEY will be paid in the ring by check made payable to CASH (60 day cashing limit). Once the award has been made, the responsibility of the HORSE SHOW shall cease. It is the responsibility of Ring 2 & 3 exhibitors to pick up prize checks when getting ribbons.
8. NEHC MEDAL RIDERS **must** present current NEHC membership card, provide their NEHC # or join prior to the class.
9. **Credentials:** Horses/Ponies entered in classes requiring registration papers must have said papers (or photo copies) available. Coggins test within 36 months for in-state equines and within 6 months for out-of-state equines must also be available. **Please list Coggins month/year on your entry blank.**
10. Downeast Medal classes are not pointed by MHA Nor NEHC

**LESSON RIDER DIVISION RULES**

**This division is open to any mount deemed suitable for a beginning/inexperienced rider.**

**It is not restricted to lesson program horses and ponies. Lesson Rider classes are NOT pointed by NEHC nor MHA.**

Open to Saddle, Hunter and Stock Seat riders. Saddle Seat riders must not have shown in any show wearing a suit and are to be attired in Kentucky jods, boots, shirt and tie (vest, gloves, optional). Helmets are mandatory for riders 11 and under. No derbies. Hunter Seat riders to be attired in jods, boots, shirt and tie/choker. **Gloves & jacket are optional with helmets mandatory for all hunt seat riders.** Stock Seat riders must not have shown in any recognized show wearing standard stock seat outfit. They are to show with boots and suitable pants, shirt and tie. Western hat/vest are optional with riding helmet mandatory for 11 and under riders.

Full bridles, snaffles with or without martingales and other suitable bridles may be used. Lesson Rider mounts may be shown in regular horse show classes by other riders. Academy riders are not to show in the regular horse show classes, and may not cross-enter among the academy divisions. Lesson Rider Equitation to be judged on basic principles of horsemanship. Lesson Rider Pleasure to be judged on manners, suitability for a novice rider, and performance with quality NOT to count. Lead Line entries must be lead by an adult.

**\$1000 Modified Hunter Derby**

To be run as **Class 130**

In Ring 2 at the conclusion of Rings 2 & 3  
2010 Judges: Fifi Schmidt and Larissa Pratt

**Eligibility**

Open to all horses/ponies and riders that have competed in at least 2 over fence classes at this show. The format of the class will be a two-round hunter classic over jumps that simulate obstacles normally found in the hunt field.

**Round One: Hunter Classic Course**

All competitors will jump a course of 10 fences at 2'6 with 4 option fences at 2'9. The course shall include at least one in and out, one bending line and one line with an unrelated distance. To be judged on hunter style, quality, soundness, movement and brilliance in the horse's pace.

**Round Two: Handy Hunter Course**

The top 8 competitors will return in reverse order to jump a handy hunter round, which will include at least 2 of the following: trot jump, tight turn option, halt and/or back and hand gallop a fence. To be judged on style, soundness, brilliance and handiness. A maximum of 10 bonus points may be awarded by the judges to each horse/rider combination for the handiness of the round and the brilliance of their pace.

**Judging Format**

The Derby class will have a panel of 2 judges using the open numerical scoring system. Scores will be announced after each competitor finishes their course. The option fences will be considered as a way for the rider to show his horse's ability over a variety of jumps, and will carry a higher value in the scoring process.

An order of go will be drawn by the secretary and posted 1 hour before the class begins.

**Ribbons to Eighth Place. All top 8 riders must ride for awards.**
