## General Rules:

1. Every class recognized by the Maine Horse Association will be conducted and judged under the current rules of the Maine Horse Association, Inc.
2. Entry fees: \$10 regular classes, \$15 championship, stake, and medal classes. Unjudged warm-ups \$8 per horse/pony. Post entry fee \$15 for all entries not received by Friday, 7/23. \$4 per horse/pony for MHA Trophy Fund
3. Unjudged warm-ups will be available from 6:30-7:45, classes will begin promptly at 8:00.
4. Show ring is outdoor sand ring. Warm-up area with sand footing is available.
5. No refunds will be granted without certificate from veterinarian/physician.
6. Six (6) ribbons will be awarded per class. Prize money will be awarded in cash at the secretary's booth following the awarding of ribbons. Management assumes no responsibility for prize money lost once out of management's possession.
7. For Championship and Hunter Stake classes, entries must have been entered, shown and judged in the class listed in parentheses ( ).
8. Championship and reserve championship awards, based on points, will be awarded in the following divisions: Short Stirrup Equitation, Easy Does It Hunter, Schooling Hunter, Special Working Hunter, Pony Working Hunter, and Low Working Hunter.
9. All dogs MUST be kept on a leash at all times. Any dog found loose will be impounded and the owner charged \$20.
10. Food will be available on the grounds.
11. **WARNING:** Under Maine State Law an equine professional has limited liability for an injury or death resulting from the inherent risks of any equine activities.
12. No horse may enter a class until an entry blank has been completed, fees paid and number assigned. Management has the right to decline an entry without liability.
13. Proof of negative Coggins is required for all horses, within 36 months for in-state horses, 6 months for out-of-state.

## Downeast Medal Specifications:

Entrants must perform over a minimum of eight fences (four rails in the walk-trot) with at least one change of direction. 25% of riders (a minimum of 2) must be called back for individual testing.

Walk-Trot Poles: Riders 14 and under, must not have shown over fences higher than 18". Trot minimum of four poles. Verbal testing encouraged.

Junior Mini-Medal: Riders 17 and under, must not compete during the year over fences higher than 18". Fences 18", tests 1-8.

Children's Medal: Riders 17 and under. Fences 2'3", tests 1-8.

Pony Medal: Riders 17 and under, competing on ponies. Fences 2'3" (sm/med), 2'6" (large), tests 1-19.

Junior Medal: Riders 17 and under. Fences 2'9", tests 1-19.

Modified Adult Medal: Riders 18 and older. Fences 2'3", tests 1-8.

Amateur Adult Medal: Riders 18 and older. Fences 2'9", tests 1-19.

**Directions:**

**From the South via the Maine Turnpike:**

Take Exit 25 (formerly Exit 3) in Kennebunk. Follow signs to Route 35 North. Stay on Route 35 through Kennebunk and Lyman. Turn left on Route 5 North in Dayton. Park is 2.5 miles on left.

**From the North via the Maine Turnpike:**

Take Exit 46 (formerly Exit 7B) in South Portland. Turn left out of the toll booth and then left onto Route 22 West. Take Route 22 through Westbrook, Scarborough, Gorham and into Buxton. Turn left on Route 202 South into HollisCenter. Turn left, heading South, on Route 35. Turn right on Clark's Mills Road. At the end of Clark's Mills road, turn left on Route 5. Park is immediately on your right.

**From Route 202 (Sanford area):**

Turn right, heading South, on Route 5 in North Waterboro. Continue right on Route 5 toward Saco. Park will be on your right, approx 1 mile from where Route 5 and Route 202 part.

**From Route 5 (Saco area):**

Drive North on Route 5 through Dayton. Park will be on your left approx. 2.5 miles north of the Route 35 intersection.
