General Rules:

1. Every class recognized by the Maine Horse Association will be conducted and judged under the current rules of the MHA. Six ribbons in all classes; trophies and money as indicated. Money will be presented in the form of vouchers which must be redeemed or used toward show expenses by the end of the show day. Management's responsibility for prize money shall cease when the voucher is presented in the ring and will not be replaced if lost.
2. No horse may enter a class unless an entry blank has been completed, fees paid, and number assigned.
3. Show Ring is sand ring. Indoor will be available if inclement weather and is also sand footing.
4. Entry fees \$15.00 per class, \$20.00 per medal, stake and championship classes. MHA fee \$4.00 per horse/pony \$25.00 post entry fee per horse and rider. Entries close 5/28 and 8/5 2010.
5. Championship & Reserve will be awarded for Easy Does It, Schooling Hunter, Special Hunter, Children's Hunter, Low Hunter, and will be based on points. (No entry fee)
6. Food will be available on the grounds; Lunch break if any, will be announced.
7. No refunds without note from veterinarian or medical doctor.
8. Class 1 Hi-Lo any horse rider combination one round at desired height. To be judged on manners and performance.
9. All dogs must be leashed!
10. In Stake/Championship classes, entry must have been entered, shown and judged in class in parentheses.
11. Warm-up will be held from 6:30 - 8:00 at 2ft. \$10.00 per horse/rider combination. The Hi-Lo Class will have an open card all day.
12. At the August show the Trainer/Student Challenge: Trainer and Student will jump a 6 to 8 jump course each receiving their own score. The team with the highest combined score will be the winner. Trainer is allowed to compete on as many horses as they wish. Students are not limited to 1 horse they can have as many rides as they want but only 1 per each horse. Horses can be used for different riders as well and scores will be given per each team. Entry fee is \$40 per team. Prize Money will be awarded at end of show.

Directions:

From 295 take exit 28 Bath/Brunswick. Follow Route 1 north until you get to Reunion Station Restaurant. Take a left and go past the Restaurant. At fork in the road take left. Take left onto Lower Cross Rd follow until Stop Sign go left and SWS is about 300 feet up on the left.
