General Rules:

1. Every class recognized by the Maine Horse Association will be conducted and judged under the current rules of the MHA. 12 ribbons will be awarded in Medal Finals classes, 8 in all other classes.
2. Show ring is a covered arena with sand footing.
3. No dogs except on a leash
4. No horse may enter a class until an entry form has been completed, fees paid and number assigned. Management has the right to decline an entry without liability.
5. To be eligible for Stake Classes, horses must have entered and shown in its respective over fence class indicated in parentheses ().
6. Entry fees: Warm-up \$25; Regular Classes \$30; Medal Classes and Classics \$50
7. Stabling: \$75 per horse or tack stall for the show. Stalls available after 2pm Friday until 6pm Sunday. Stall fee does not include bedding.
8. Fairground requires \$10.00 a day per Horse/Pony.
9. MHA \$4 trophy fee per horse/pony. Entries received or postmarked past 9/12/09 will be charged a \$25 post entry fee per horse/rider combination. NO EXCEPTIONS
10. Food will be available on the grounds; lunch break will be announced
11. Positively no refunds without certificate from medical doctor or veterinarian.
12. Show starts at 8:30am
13. Warm-ups will be supervised. No more than 5 horses at a time.
14. Classics will be run as follows: Riders with highest scores will be invited back for second course (min 50%)

Directions:

From I-95, take Exit 133 (formerly Exit 36) and turn right onto Rte 201 North. Travel approximately 15miles to Skowhegan. In Skowhegan follow 201North (right) across the bridge into town and stay in the left lane around the buildings. Turn right at the stoplight staying on Rte 201North. The Fairgrounds is on the left at the third set of lights (Hannaford).
