PRIZE LIST CHECKLIST FOR AFFILIATED SHOWS

2. Sponsor of Show

OFFICIALS: Judge(s) Town State

NOTE: A judge may not officiate at more than one affiliated show during any twenty-day period except in the case of an emergency as determined by the Steward.

Steward

NOTE: No steward may officiate for more than two consecutive years at the same competition or at more than two consecutive competitions run by the same governing body,

Manager

Must be an MHA member

Secretary

Farrier

Must be on the grounds. (Exception: May be on call for a hunter-jumper show.)

Veterinarian

On the grounds On call/Phone Number

First Aid Arrangements

You may list a specific person with his/her credentials or you may list the agency providing on the grounds coverage. EXCEPTION: One day show may list RESCUE # only. On grounds not required.

The above officials must be listed on the prize list sent to prospective exhibitors. TBA will not be accepted. Other officials such as ringmaster, gatekeepers, announcer, etc. are optional to put on the prize list.

ENTRY & SHOW POLICY INFORMATION:

MHA Statement - which covers any omission or inadvertent error EVERY CLASS RECOGNIZED BY THE MAINE HORSE ASSOCIATION WILL BE CONDUCTED AND JUDGED UNDER THE CURRENT RULES OF THE MAINE HORSE ASSOCIATION, INC.

Entry Fees INCLUDING the MHA Fee: \$4.00 per horse or pony (\$8 for double-judged)

Policy on Post Entries including the closing date for entries

Refund Policy

RIBBONS, TROPHIES, MONEY

Six ribbons must be awarded in all classes.

If Prize Money is given, it must be awarded to at least four places.

Indication of money prizes or trophies for each class. (Class D, ribbons only)

Statement of how prize money will be awarded (in ring by cash, check, voucher, etc.)

Statement of when Management Responsibility for 'lost' prize money ceases

Cannot give prize money in equitation (including adult) nor YA Showmanship

## Class List Information

\_\_\_ If **more than one judge**, indicate judging assignments by ring or division  
If **double-judged**, must state whether they'll be judging individually or concurrently (specify 'call judge')

\_\_\_ **Schedule** of classes (order of classes) by session

\_\_\_ **Starting time** for at least the first session of the day.

A starting time for each session is recommended as this helps the judge to pace himself/herself and it helps exhibitors arriving for later classes to plan. A session cannot start more than 30 minutes ahead of the announced/posted time.

\_\_\_ **Exact titles** of MHA pointed classes are required. Class specifications are not required.

\_\_\_ Do list **age requirements** for Lead Line, Walk-Trot and Equitation classes.

NOTE: A rider's age is figured **as of the previous December 1** (NOT January 1)

\_\_\_ **Class specifications** for classes NOT in the MHA Rule Book NOR covered in another affiliation's Rule Book must be written out. Specs include 1) who is eligible 2) how class will be run 3) how class will be judged

\_\_\_ Classes **NOT MHA POINTED** must be so designated.

\_\_\_ Each show must hold the **MHA Pleasure Medallion Class** or pay triple affiliation fee

NOTES: 1) include "Open to Members & Non-members" 2) MHA provides 6 ribbons/certificate 3) entry fees are sent to MHA

\_\_\_ **MHA Pleasure Classes** must state: **Must be owned by a resident of Maine**

\_\_\_ **Clover-leaf Barrel Race/Pole Bending Competition** – List Table under which it's to be run

\_\_\_ **Championships:** Need Statement: *To be eligible, must have been entered, shown and judged in Class \_\_\_.*

\_\_\_ **Stakes:** May or may not require a qualifying class; generally indicate higher amount of prize money; stakes gets regular points NOT championship points

**Multi-day Shows:** \_\_\_ **Stabling Arrangements** must include type of stalls; bedding, hay, grain availability; tack/horse stall costs, plus arrival/departure times ON A RESERVATION FORM

**Entry Blank:** \_\_\_ **Must** include the DISCLAIMER STATEMENT that starts "*Every entry at an affiliated event...*"

\_\_\_ **Must** include the \$4 per horse/pony awards fee (\$8 for double-judged show)

### **Hunter/Jumper Shows:**

\_\_\_ Hunter Seat Equitation must state whether **On the Flat** or **Over Fences not to exceed** \_\_\_

\_\_\_ Hunter Seat Equitation Championship **MUST** be over fences for points to count.

\_\_\_ Hunter Stake generally requires a qualifying class. Blanket statement may be used: *In each hunter division, to be eligible for its Stake class, entry must have been entered shown and judged in its respective 'over fences' class.*

\_\_\_ **Hunter/Jumper Division Show Championships** are based on points earned in the each three-class division. To count for points the following statement must appear: *Championship & Reserve Championship awards, based on points (no entry fee) in respective divisions will be awarded in \_\_\_ (list divisions) \_\_\_.* OR it may be listed after the third class in each division. (eg Award -- \_\_\_\_\_ Hunter Champion & Reserve)

\_\_\_ Statements concerning **type of course** (inside, outside, enclosed field, sandy ring, etc.). **schooling policy, warm-up arrangements** and **practice area.**

\_\_\_ **Height of Fences** for each division must be listed – at least the maximum (not to exceed \_\_\_)

The height listed for the first class in the division will cover the whole division.

\_\_\_ **Jumper Classes** must list the starting fence height plus the Table/Section under which the class will run.
